Subsequent to the reading of a statement of compliance with the notice requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act, the Commission considered and took formal action on the following matters:

1. By a vote of 3-0, remanded the initial application of Rajendra N. Paul for a casino key employee license to a hearing (Exhibit EL-2*; transcript pages 6-7).
2. Considered the petition of Revel Entertainment Group, LLC (*d/b/a* Revel) and issued the following ruling:

By a vote of 3-0, adopted the draft resolution and authorized Jeffrey E. Hartmann, on a temporary basis and prior to his plenary qualification, to assume the duties and exercise the powers as Interim Chief Executive Officer for Revel Entertainment Group, LLC, pending plenary qualification, subject to the conditions contained in *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-85.1 c; *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-89b (1), *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-89b (2) and *N.J.A.C.* 13:69C-2.7. Further, granted the petitioners' request to waive the residency requirement, as provided for in *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-89(b) 4 (PRN 0521302) (Ruling number 13-03-19-02; transcript pages 7-17).

There being no members of the public to address the Commission, the meeting adjourned at 9:56 a.m.
