DESCRIPTION OF ESSENTIAL DUTIES: Under the general supervision of the Manager of Licensing & Financial Evaluation, supervises and/or undertakes the preparation of highly technical analyses and/or prepares reports that evaluate the financial condition, operating performance and financial projections of casino licensees and related companies and economic conditions under Section 82e of the Casino Control Act (undue economic concentration), Section 84 (financial stability), and Section 87 (casino license applicants). Supervises and/or undertakes the certification and review of casino parking fee revenue in accordance with Section 173.5 of the Casino Control Act. Supervises and/or undertakes the evaluation, summarization, and maintenance of financial information. Performs other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college with a Bachelor's degree in accounting, business administration or finance, including or supplemented by a minimum of 21 credit hours in any combination of accounting, statistics, finance, or economics subjects.

Note: No education substitution.

EXPERIENCE: Minimum of four years of professional accounting, financial analysis or auditing experience, one year of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity. Proficiency in spreadsheet and word processing applications. Proficiency in the use of other software applications and Internet research may be required. CPA preferred.

Substitution: Possession of a valid Certified Public Accountant license issued by the NJ State Board of Accountancy and/or a Master's degree in accounting, finance or business administration may be substituted for one year of the required non-supervisory experience.
